Suitable for all abilities - Equipment List

Please can students bring as much of the following as possible.

There will be a limited amount of tools and materials to borrow.

Drawing board or desk easel (A2 if possibly but A3 or any size better than nothing)

(if you can't bring one please say so when booking so we can make sure there is something here for you to use)

Mitchell/ Rexel square cut roundhand nibs (both same make), sizes 2 2.5 3 3.5 4 (left oblique for left handers)

2 slippon reservoirs (the ones with 2 little holes in) 1 or more penholders

Bottle black calligraphy ink eg Pelikan 4001 or any Japanese liquid ink

A3 pad of Goldline or Daler-Rowney lay-out paper

A3 pad of Winsor & Newton SMOOTH cartridge, 60,70 or 100lbs weight IF you want to make finished pieces rather than just practice

Ruler, HB pencil, Pritt gluestick, scissors and/or cheap craft knife, tape eg 1" masking tape, water pot (Cycle Café can supply jam jars)

Optional: If you want to write in colour, 1 or more tubes of Winsor & Newton designer's gouache (not ones marked primary), get series 1 or 2 (cheapest), cheap mixing brush, and small mixing palette with sections,

ANY other calligraphy tools and materials you already have and are easily transportable!
